HENRY 595 Cove Base Adhesive

Description

HENRY® 595 Cove Base Adhesive is a high-performance, solvent-free, white adhesive used in the installation of rubber, vinyl and carpet cove base.

Use For

Rubber, vinyl and carpet cove base.

Bonds To

Refer to the cove base manufacturer for acceptable substrates.

HENRY 595 bonds to concrete, concrete block, gypsum drywall, plaster, wood, plywood, brick, plastic laminate and mechanically abraded metal on all grade levels. Surfaces must be structurally sound, clean, smooth and dry.

Preparation

Refer to the cove base manufacturer's specific recommendations.

Acclimate the installation area, adhesive and cove base in an enclosed building at a minimum of 65°F (18°C) for at least 48 hours before, during and for 48 hours after installation.

Substrate must be sound, smooth and flat in accordance with the cove base manufacturer's recommendations. Ensure that the substrate is solid and securely fixed to provide a rigid base free of undue flex. All loose boards and panels must be re-nailed to create a sound surface.

Substrate must be clean, dry and free of excess moisture and alkali. Mechanically remove dirt, wax, grease, paints, oils, sealers, curing compounds and all foreign matter that would interfere with proper adhesion. Fill all cracks, holes and low spots.

Glazed or metal surfaces must be roughened mechanically.

Installation

Follow the cove base manufacturer's guidelines for layout and design.

11 oz. or 30 oz. tube

Apply with a standard closed-barrel gun or open-barrel skeleton gun.

Closed barrel gun: Cut spout about 1/2" (12.7 mm) from top of tube. Puncture inner seal. Insert cartridge, and attach nozzle.

Skeleton gun: Cut spout near tip to produce 1/8" (3.2 mm) bead. Puncture inner seal, and insert cartridge. Use two beads for $2\ 1/2$ " / 63.55 mm cove base, three beads for 4" / 10 cm cove base and five beads for 6" / 15.24 cm cove base.

1 Gallon or 4 Gallon Pail

Use recommended trowel to spread adhesive to the back of the cove base or directly to the substrate.

Leave a 1/8" (3.2 mm) clearance at the top of the cove base to prevent adhesive oozing.

Set cove base immediately into wet adhesive. Press firmly to the wall, rubbing across the face of the cove base with a soft cloth. To ensure a tight fit, rub toward previously installed section.

Do not allow a heavy film to form on the surface of the adhesive. If the adhesive dries or skins over, it must be scraped up, and fresh adhesive needs to be applied.

Cleanup

Remove wet adhesive residue with a clean, white cloth dampened with soapy water. Use mineral spirits for dried adhesive residue. When using mineral spirits, carefully follow the recommendations of the manufacturer, and test a small area before proceeding to make sure it does not damage the surface being cleaned.
